**Minutes of Seminar on Sahaja Krishi held on 06.01.2022 in online mode
G. B. Pant University of Agriculture and Technology, Pantnagar, Uttarakhand**


On January 06, 2022, a seminar was organized with the kind permission of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of G. B. Pant University of Agriculture and Technology, Pantnagar for starting 'Sahaja Krishi' project by involving Crop Research Centre (CRC) under Directorate of Research in the university. The points discussed and resolutions finalized in the seminar are listed below:

1. The purpose of this short, but very innovative seminar was to evaluate whether permission to Sahajakrishi - a technique used to increase productivity with the help of vibrations envisaged by Her Holiness Mataji Shri Nirmala Devi -could be useful, yet as an another way to open new vistas in agrarian technology. Yes, it was something hard to believe but as Professor Virendra Singh, retired Professor from Palampur Agriculture University, Palampur, Himachal Pradesh, threw this hypothesis in the open minds of think-tank to see themselves by empirical research. Professor Virendra Singh has done studies on the vibratory use on agriculture and presented a paper elaborately citing conclusive evidences of research findings of various scholars on Sahaja Krishi. Many Indian as well as foreign scholars have been pressing hard to make believe to this divine technique of vibratory awareness.
2. With the efforts of some professors of G. B. Pant University of Agriculture and Technology, Pantnagar who have been blessed with the unimaginable results of these vibrations, this seminar could be organized to get the recommendations of the Director Research, G B Pant University of Agriculture and Technology, Pantnagar so as to use this innovative technique for the benefits of the people at large.
3. Prof. A. K. Pratihar, Prof., Department of Mechanical Engineering, Prof. R.S.Jadoun, Dean, College of Agribusiness Management, Pantnagar and Dr. H. R. Jaiswal, a scientist of Vegetable Research Centre (VRC) have offered voluntary services in trying to assimilate divine vibrations by the orthodox patterns of agrarian technology.

4. Shri G.D. Pareek, Joint Director, Agriculture Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur and National Coordinator, Sahaj Agriculture, India also shared experiences of Sahaja krishi compiled under his supervision. How chemical bond of water molecule changes with these vibrations was also discussed and complete research findings on this subject by one other researcher remained a finding of great interest.
5. Dr. Narendra Kumar Sharma, doctorate from JNU and Assistant Professor in Subodh College, under Rajasthan University, also a legal practitioner in the Supreme court of India, an ardent believer of Sahaja yoga, explained lucidly the practical experience he had 23 years ago, to make him a State Coordinator of Himachal Pradesh in Sahaja yoga in the year 2012, thereafter making him a full time preacher of Sahaja yoga. Unless you get your self-realization, you cannot know the meaning of yourself, is the base of this theory, as has been asserted by Shri Mataji Nirmala Devi, the propounder of this Sahaja Krishi technique. To undertake Sahaja krishi, we need to have the experience of vibrations which is possible only after our connection with the Divine, he emphasized categorically.
6. Professor Chetna Bajaj of English Literature from Government College Gurdaspur also shared her valuable experiences. Born in an orthodox Sikh family, it is out of question to follow other than Granth Sahib, she uttered frankly about the success of Sahajkrishi. However, the day she got her Realization, Shri Granth Sahib has been understood in the divine light. Dharma is not something outside; it's our nature she proclaimed.
7. Shri Mayank Gupta discussed about very good results obtained by him in Sahaja Krishi and shared a video of five acre bamboo farming in Roorkee, Uttarakhand.
8. Prof. A.S. Nain, Director Research, Pantnagar University was anxious enough to start a trial on this proposition of Dr Narendra Kumar Sharma that we cannot deny what has been said, unless we experiment. Saying that we need to start a trial, for the Sahaja Krishi techniques of vibrations, Director Research agreed to conduct two experiments on Sahaja Agriculture at Pantnagar, Uttarakhand during 2022. Director Research raised two queries about any device to measure vibrations and to know it's effects on wild animals. He enquired whether these vibrations have something to deal with menace of monkeys and other wild animals. Yes, it has been seen that wild animals don't come near the area of vibrations, assured Dr. G.D. Pareek.
9. Ultimately, Prof Nain, Director Research accepted the proposal for Sahaja Krishi, for which trials will be started on Moog pulse in the month of February, 2022.
10. Dr. H. R. Jaiswal, a scientist of vegetable research centre and a Sahajayogi proposed vote of thanks to everyone for their active participation and cooperation.
